Henry Roberts was Mr. Sunshine and recognized Alan Bookman and Sally Fox their prowess in the field of law and that it was also "Mental Health Week" – maybe the two are related? He went on to test all on some simple logic questions and many were probably baffled and failed miserably (at least I did). Birthdays were recognized and we were off to the Program. Introduced was one of our own, Dee Dee Flounlaker with Manna. Executive Director since 2011. Dee Dee enlightened Rotarians about all that has been going on since Covid hit. What has been most dramatic is the massive increase in food that has been required in the community and that donations have stopped as a precaution. Manna has done their best to keep up but they have burned through assets (\$65,000 just last month) to buy food instead of using donated food that pre-Covid, made up 95% of their meal output. They closed all the pantries and have partnered with 18 other groups, up from six, in order to get the food out as well. Manna has also made it a priority to continue to feed seniors at home and is currently providing this service to over 65 homes. She went on and is worried that there is no end in sight to the needs that are in the community for food. There were a few questions and the meeting was adjourned.
