Today's speaker was Sweneda McDonald from the Lakeview Center. She enthusiastically told us of the Center and of the Medication-Assisted Treatment program which is a targeted approach to improving the lives of addicts. Addiction can occur with very little drug use. Withdrawal is especially intense for opiates and street drugs are laced with fentanyl. Lakeview has partnered with the state to create MAT and provide help for people addicted to prescription painkillers and other opiates. In addition to questions, many in the audience spoke about the great work that Sweneda and Lakeview has done for those addicted. MAT provides FDA approved medicines, and a patient will meet daily with a doctor and counselors. To receive Lakeview services, a prospective patient may voluntarily call in or be referred. Both inpatient and outpatient services are provided.
