WEEK IN REVIEW 07/28/2020

The Rotary Club of Pensacola's Zoom meeting was called to order by President Sally Fox on Tuesday, 28 July, 2020 at 12:03 PM. President Fox reminded all of her REEFS goal. Ted Brown provided the Prayer and Pledge. There were 59 members participating in the meeting.

Chris Kelly, Program Chair, after some announcements, introduced our very own Rotarian and President of UWF, Martha Saunders, as our speaker today.

President Saunders acknowledged the unusual and difficult decisions that were required to manage during this pandemic. She stated that it was first important to reflect on the mission of the university and the long-term goals. Highlights of the year so far are that UWF in conjunction with IHMC has begun Florida's first doctoral program in intelligent systems and robotics. Dr. Kristin "Brent" Venable is the director of this program. It has attracted highly qualified applicants – so many that not all can be accepted.

The university has launched the Guardian Campus Safety App, keeping students safe on campus. They have a Cyber Security Grant to assist students studying in that field.

The University of West Florida has been awarded the 2019 Higher Education Excellence in Diversity, or HEED, Award from INSIGHT Into Diversity magazine. The award recognizes U.S. colleges and universities that demonstrate an outstanding commitment to diversity and inclusion. UWF also received this national honor in 2015, 2016 and 2018. They have also received the Gold Award as a Military Friendly School.

And never forget that football team! UWF is the NCAA Division2 Champion and will remain so until or maybe even after football is resumed.

In March, the campus went online only, sending students home. 150 remained on campus as they had nowhere to go. With experience from hurricane planning, the faculty was able to activate their e-learning shells and students hung in there. There were creative online counseling, health and wellness courses, and federal funding through CARES for students. UWF was able to refund housing and dining plans. They extended deadlines so that students were not charged cancellation fees. UWF recognized that families had many difficult decisions to make. The faculty helped each other in "how" to teach online. And WUWF kept everyone up to date.

Enrollment was actually up 7% this summer and is now holding strong for Fall. Reopening in the Fall will start August 21. UWF is working with the county and the city in ways to manage safely. President Saunders has great confidence in the spirit of UWF. Not to mention that she is herself a very upbeat cheerleader. President Saunders will teach a class in Leadership Communication the Fall and this group of Rotarians just experienced her first class!

Scott Grissett reminded us all that Lisa York has made a Beach Basket for auction, the proceeds will go to the Rotary Foundation.

Allan Bookman provided Sunshine and several virus jokes. Birthdays were recognized and some singing ensued.

President Sally Fox recognized the following Paul Harris fellows: Dr. Kaberi Samanta, Frank Beall +1, and Julie Tippins Parker +1.
