Our regular Tuesday meeting was held on a chilly, but sunny day at New World Landing. Members were warmly greeted by Laura Gilliam and Mike Doman. Raffle tickets were sold by Laura Gilliam and Sally Fox. The meeting was called to order by President Betty, who led us in the 4 Way Test. Richard Sherrill led us in the prayer and pledge. President Betty reminded everyone that the board meeting would take place directly after today's meeting. John Appleyard took the podium to deliver a resolution honoring the life of Roberth Gaines, who recently passed away. Dr. Ed Renalli introduced our newest member, Sorna, who we will need to work on saying or spelling her last name. Chris Kelly delivered sunshine and we sang Happy Birthday to all of our members who were celebrating their special day this week.

Mark Harden introduced our guest speakers who spoke to us about Cyber Security. Bert Merritt, Executive Director and Jeff Ward, Director of network and telecommunications for Pensacola State College. They explained the various threats that we face with online communica-

tions and ways to protect ourselves. The biggest threats to our personal information and workplace information occurs when there is a mistake with data entry, perimeter data leaks, accidental sharing of information and of course, social engineering. Social engineering refers to phishing, smishing, and vishing (voice mail). 90 to 95% of data breaches start with phishing. Phishing scams come through as emails. Signs to look for in these emails are hint of intimidation, grammar, and the "click here". A simple way to check for phishing email is to mouse over the click here box to see the email address that it will take you to. Use these other tips to help protect yourself. Be suspicious, not naïve. Be careful of clicking on sites, be careful with social media, disable phone location service, avoid public wifi, secure your home networks, use layered security approach and don't forget human layers. The presentation was very helpful. We hope they will come back soon.

President Betty thanked the volunteers and adjourned the meeting.
