WEEK IN REVIEW 9/7/2021

The September 7 meeting of the Rotary club of Pensacola was held online via Zoom. President Ed Wonders convened the group at 12:04 pm and led us in the four way test.

Rotarian Hugh Hamilton led us in a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Rotarian and Program Chair, Joe Vinson, welcomed today's guest speaker and fellow Rotarian from Pensacola North, Leon Hirsh. By day, Leon is a Certified Financial Planner with the Benjamin F. Edwards Company. He graduated from the Kentucky Military Institute in Louisville and Transylvania University in Lexington. He is also a published columnist and Dixieland jazz musician who enjoys Carolina Beach music, tennis, and golf. Leon has been a Rotarian since 1984. Among his leadership roles, he served as District Governor in 2015-16, was the Florida PETS A.G. Trainer in 2016 and 2018, and has been the Rotary Leadership Institute Discussion Leader Trainer. He is a Paul Harris Fellow Major Donor and currently serves as our District 6940 Polio Programs Chair.

Rotarian Hirsh provided a meaningful overview of the Polio Program operated by Rotary International which began its fight against polio with a multi-year project to immunize 6 million children in the Philippines in 1979. By 1985, Rotary International launched PolioPlus, the first and largest internationally coordinated private-sector support of a public health initiative, with an initial fundraising target of \$120 million. Soon after, Rotary International and the World Health Organization launched the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. There are an estimated 350,000 cases of polio in 125 countries. By Y2K, a record 550 million children – almost 10% of the world's population – receive the oral polio vaccine. The Western Pacific region, spanning from Australia to China, is declared

polio-free. Just last year, the World Health Organization certifies the African region wild polio-free.

President Wonders' kicked off his remarks by recapping the wonderful weekend of football. He reminded Pensacola Rotarians that his Jayhawks are 7 and 87. Meanwhile UWF Argos ARE amazing. President Ed shared an important date: National Beer Lovers Day. And he shared that next week the meeting will convene in person at the PYC.

Rotarian Charles Beall brough additional sunshine by remarking that UWF won "up a level" by defeating an NCAA division one squad. He shared a bit of vaccine satire and welcomed two guests.

Rotarian Beall's humor was memorable as he shared information about a marriage improvement workshop traveling the country. The leaders divided up the rooms, women in one room, men in other — as they try to address the imbalance of power among couples. The leaders asked the men to stand up and move forward if they were afraid of their wife. Only one man remained seated. The leader asked: "Sir can you explain your secret to a successful balance of power in your relationship?"

"My wife told me to stay in my seat until she got back."
