WEEK IN REVIEW

MINUTES

Carol Law and Gary Lewis greeted all Rotarians, visitors and guests with a warm greeting and firm handshake. Rotarian Jeff Lewis assisted by Sargent at Arms Tim Kane sold raffle tickets.

President Alan called the meeting to order and wrestled with the microphone before asking Rotarian Earl Hutto to lead us in prayer. After the prayer, Rotarian Earl led Rotarians in the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag.

President Alan then asked former President Ray to the podium for a special presentation. President Ray recognized Rotarian Eric Nickelsen for achieving status as a Paul Harris Plus donor. What a great honor for a worthy Rotarian. President Alan noted again the successes of the Downtown Rotary in the year just concluded and the Presidential Citation award earned under former President Ray's leadership. The club then gave President Ray (and his board) a standing ovation for a job well done!

President Alan then called Rotarian Frank Beall to the podium for Sunshine. There were no military guests today. Rotarian Frank introduced those who celebrate birthdays this week and led us in a rousing "happy birthday you all." Rotarian Ted Brown was the lucky winner of \$66 in this week's raffle.

President Alan then called upon this year's program chair to introduce this week's speaker, Ed Spears. Ed is the Executive Director of the Community Maritime Park Associates. Ed provided a very comprehensive update on the progress being made at the site with great pictures showing the project at various stages. Ed noted that in the 1960's, area was used as a petroleum distribution location which resulted in significant soil contamination issues which had to be addressed prior to construction.

Ed told us that the stadium and field sit at 15 feet above the median high tide level. To achieve this, much fill dirt was

brought to the site. Progress on the stadium is proceeding on schedule although the acquisition of the Double "A" baseball team has resulted in some modifications to the stadium design to accommodate league rules. Notwithstanding, the construction is proceeding nicely and the contractor expects the project to conclude on time. Ed told that plans for a 48 wet, slip marina on the west side of the project remain in place. Parking will initially be 355 surface spaces on the northwest corner of the project with additional parking at various nearby locations such as City Hall.

At the conclusion of the remarks, Rotarian John thanked Ed for keeping the club updated on progress at the park. Ed invited Rotarians to contact him for a tour of the facilities as they continue to take shape. President Alan thanked everyone who worked on today's program and then declared our meeting adjourned.
