Our guest speaker this week was Meghan McCarthy, who did an outstanding presentation on "Partnership for a Healthy Community". Meghan leads the "Healthy Lives Program" at Baptist Health Care. She has masters degrees in business administration and in public health. She develops and manages work site wellness programs in Pensacola, including those at Pen Air Federal Credit Union, Land rum, Pensacola Christian College, Refinish and others. partners with The Greater Pensacola Chamber of Commerce and Live Well Northwest Florida. She provided us with simple, easy choices to help us become healthier. She broke down the food groups into three categories - Fat, Carbs, and Protein. Fat – There are three types of fat. Saturated fat (solid at room temp) more difficult for your heart to move and usually comes from animal sources. Unsaturated Fat (liquid at room temp) is easier for your heart to move and usually comes from a plant source. Trans fat (the worst)

is man-made and should be avoided in all diets.

Carbs – Carbs are the body's primary source of energy. Complex carbs provide higher nutrient content, fiber and are more filling. Simple carbs are primarily sugar and are bad for you. Protein – Most adults need about 55 grams of protein per day. Proteins are found in meat, eggs and nuts and vegetables.

She also explained the importance of good nutrition. Maintaining weight is 75% nutrition and only 25% exercise. The most important tip was to avoid TRANSFAT. She also offered suggestions for an easy way to get a little extra exercise each and every day. For instance, when going to the restroom, always go to the farthest one. Do 5 chair squats on each trip to the restroom. By doing these simple things, you will be working toward being a little bit healthier. She also reminded us that Baptist offers free smoking cessation classes.

John reminded all of us about the Playground Grand Opening that will be held at 5:30 on Monday, July 20th. This is an event that we have all been looking forward to. The meeting was then closed by Past President John.
