The meeting was called to order by our New President, Paul Tobin, who led us in the Four Way Test. He drew past President Sherri Hartnett's lucky raffle ticket for a prize of \$46.00.

Frank Beall led us in Prayer and Pledge. We were then treated to Sunshine by Dale Jordan. He introduced our two newest members, and our military guests – Kyle Wilhouse from VT 86 and Collin McNamara from Training Squadron 86. He also introduced Roger Folker, our visiting Rotarian.

President Paul introduced Brett Barrow, who came to the podium to introduce our guest speaker, Dr. Peter Rubardt with the Pensacola Symphony.

Dr. Rubardt has been with the Symphony for 20 years. He explained that they have three areas of focus for the Symphony: Artistic Institutes, Community Engagement, and Building Capacity.

The first item: Artistic Institutes would bring world renowned artists, focus on broadening the repertoire, and collaboration with non-arts organizations. The second focus of community engagement is to add value through a program called "Beyond the Stage". This adds value by providing music as a service to the community. Parts of this program include school Orchestra program, performing in neighborhood, children's hospitals and various community events. He pointed out that attendance is continuously rising and attributes most of the increase to this program.

The next steps are to expand capability and add partners. Anyone interested in participating is invited to contact the Symphony.

The Maestro told us about the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Concerts being performed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. On the 3<sup>rd</sup>, there will be a performance at the Seaside Resort and on the 4<sup>th</sup>, the Symphony will be performing at our very own Maritime Park. Gates open at 5:30 and all are invited to the free performance. So please come out and show your support.

The meeting was then adjourned by President Paul.
