Rick Fountain introduced the Speaker for the day, Melissa Brode, Assistant Dean of the College of Business and Director of the MBA program. the University of West Florida MBA program is fully accredited by AACSB - The International Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. AACSB accreditation represents the highest standard for business schools worldwide, with less than 5% of programs in the world achieving this accreditation.

The mission of the MBA Program is to prepare working and aspiring professionals with the skills necessary to embrace business opportunities through high-impact

educational experiences. These experiences include the use of live cases in the classroom, participation in case competitions, traveling for international study abroad, and involvement in collaborative projects. Dean Brode was here to speak specifically about the Germany MBA program. The Germany MBA Program was initiated in 2002 and is a partnership between the UWF College of Business and the Transatlantik-Institut, University of Applied Sciences, Ludwigshafen on the Rhine, Germany. The 18-month program is directed at university graduates from all academic fields who have at least two years of work experience. The academic degree Master of Business Administration (MBA) is awarded by the University of West Florida (UWF) and is accepted in Germany. The program is accredited by the International Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB). Nine students from Germany who are here for the first phase of the program which is an intensive month of classes at UWF introduced themselves to the club. The students work for foreign companies such as BASF, SAP and in governmental service. To date UWF the program has awarded MBA's to 142 students through this program.

President John thanked all who made the meeting great and the meeting was adjourned.
