This is a wonderful association and is in real need for volunteers to help carry out this program. They are actively seeking volunteers and hope that some of our members will join the cause. There is a training session being held at St. Sylvester's Catholic Church in Navarre coming up in August. The classes run over a period of seven days and volunteers must attend all of the classes in order to qualify for the program.
