MINUTES

The noon meeting of the Rotary Club of Pensacola was ushered in by greeters Donnie McMahon and Ron Jackson. The meeting was opened by President Alan Bookman calling upon Rodger Doyle for our prayer and pledge. The \$72 raffle ticket sold by Trey Manderson was won by Charles Carlan. Following, Bob Hart, esquire, introduced our visiting military guest, representing the U.S. Navy, visitors and visiting Rotarians. There were no birthday celebrants present but Bob did bring us some excellent sunshine humor.

Former District Governor, Ted Kirzharr introduced our new District Governor, Jeanne Quave for our program. Jeanne is a member of the Panama City Beach Club, Paul Harris Fellow, and formally involved in the development of the Edgewater Beach Resort at Panama City Beach. She was accompanied by her daughters, Molly and Olivia. She attended the National Conference in San Diego, CA in January of this year and spoke of the new Rotary International President, Kalyan Banerjee's theme, "Reach Within to Embrace Humanity". R.I. President Kalyan believes we must start with ourselves and work outward to our families and then throughout the

world to make us happier, healthier and more peaceful.

Jeanne has learned to balance her family life with her Rotary life as District Governor making sacrifices to accomplish her goals. She recently went on a Rotary trip to Haiti along with other Florida Rotary District Governors. It was a beautiful sight from the air but upon arrival, the realization of the harsh situation that existed hit all participants. Their mission was to check on Rotary programs, a fishing farm that is raising food for the population there and an orphanage. Travel was difficult due to the rubble and poor road conditions with many residents living beside the road in poorly fashioned shacks. Sanitation and garbage removal were non-existent. It was a sobering experience. The minimal amount of commerce was vendors selling items they had been sent from outside the country by relatives. But most of the Haitians seemed to want to earn a living rather than depend on charity.

Upon arrival at the orphanage, the Rotary wheel was recognized and the children anticipated help and were given hope. Malnourished, dehydrated and diseased children were ever present. It was very hard for the team to leave them there. District Governor Jeanne requested that her

clubs consider assistance to Haiti as part of their service projects. She also requested continued support of Polio Plus as we are so close to eradicating Polio around the world.

This year there will be an event planned for February 25, 2012, "Rotary Rock's". Every club in the district, representing over 2500 members, will do a service project on that day to bring awareness to Rotary and our good works. Governor Jeanne's daughters, Molly and Olivia, came forward to announce the District Conference, April 29, 2012, at Edgewater Beach Resort, Panama City Beach. The theme is "It's a Jungle Out There". We were encouraged to attend and to bring our children and grandchildren to this event.
