President Alan reminded that there will **not** be a meeting on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 and that Monday, November 7, 2011 at New World Landing is Military Appreciation Day for the Combined Rotary Clubs of Pensacola. President Alan thanked all who participated and the meeting was adjourned.
