Jerry Maygarden introduced the program: Dave Wilderbrandt - President of Baptist Hospital. Dave who has been to the Club before, discussed the benefits of the recent collaboration. "a clinical association" between the Mayo Clinic and Baptist. Mayo approached Baptist in this "new" partnership as a way to gain a footprint in certain areas without having to acquire hospitals. There are 17 Mayo clinics nationwide and the closest to Pensacola is Jacksonville, Florida. Mayo has 58,000 employees and over 3,800 doctors. As far as what we will see locally, most of the interaction will be between the physicians at Mayo and Baptist - and mostly transparent to the patients. Some Mayo programs being implemented include: eConsults, "Ask Mayo Expert", Mayo Healthcare Consulting, and Mayo Branding. With eConsults, local Baptist physicians can request a consult from Mayo's best practices and within 48 hours a consult will be available aiding in diagnosis and treatment. Other benefits include reduced travel for patients, seamless case transfer to a Mayo clinic if required, and no additional cost to the patients for access to any of the Mayo services. Dave also mentioned that he sees unprecedented change coming to the health care system as we know it; all in the name of cost reduction because of how the payment system is changing. We adjourned shortly before 1:00 p.m.
