Our library system holds many special events each year that include Model Building Day, Dr. Who Day, Trivia and Game Day, and the popular summer reading series for children on summer break. Our library systems offers free computer access, books for hearing impaired, a jazz room, e-readers, free Morningstar reports, meeting rooms, and most importantly a place to slow down. Dr. Temple closed with one piece of advice: "Get a library card!"
