New projects will include an expansion of the Centennial Park, a matching grant for zero to three year old learning programs with the Studer Group, another Food for the Needy project and perhaps a restart of the very successful Wheelchair Program. the direction of Mark Hardin and ideas and feedback from the club are welcome.

Rotary Recognition Points are given for contributions to the Rotary Foundation, and these points can be used to help our members reach the giving level required for a Paul Harris Fellowship. The Club has \$58,000 in Recognition Points.

President Paul intends to have a small history segment at each meeting with inputs from John Appleyard and from his own experiences. Paul closed by telling the story of LT Hugh Barr Miller, a World War II hero and Alabama football star.
