Coach Jeffcoat follows in the footsteps of the great Jim Spooner who coached at UWF for 23 years. Currently the Argonauts are ranked third by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Division II national poll. The Argonauts are also No. 1 in the South Region at this time. Mike Jeffcoat was a standout reliever for the Argonauts in 1990-91 and helped lead the 1991 team to a league leading ERA and the best school record until the 2007 season coached by Jeffcoat that won the Gulf South Region Championship. Coach Jeffcoat was in the St. Louis Cardinals organization from 1991-1993 and has been named the Gulf

South Conference Coach of the Year. Coach Jeffcoat returned to his alma mater in 1993 and began as the pitching coach. Argonaut Baseball is one of the many premier athletic programs at UWF and as Coach Jeffcoat can relate from personal experience, Baseball means hard work on a consistent basis and the combination of athletic achievement at a high level and academic achievement creates outstanding students, graduates and members of the community. It is easy to see the benefits of the Argonaut Baseball program when you get the opportunity to meet Coach Jeffcoat and hear him speak of his players and coaches at UWF. The season schedule was distributed and all are encouraged to go out and enjoy the games. Past President Margaret adjourned by thanking all who served.
